



Doesn't that feel better? Nicely done, neighbors! Surprisingly, the trucks filled so quickly, that by 10:30 we had to turn folks away. How frustrating to have loaded a vehicle to dump and then not have been able to dump it! We apologize for the inconvenience and the Board is brainstorming ways to avoid this happening in the future. We're asking for your suggestions. One idea is to hire a landscaping company to provide a chipper to deal with the broken tree branches that so many brought, thus freeing up room in the garbage trucks. Another idea is to require reservations (available to only those who have paid their annual dues in advance) – so we can reliably anticipate a final count and line up a third truck, if demand was there for it. 


